We have and will continue to use local village elders and council leaders to distribute rice. It is absolutely the most efficient way to ensure rice goes to those who most need it while ensuring it does not feed livestock or get resold locally. These local leaders, while trustworthy, do not have the capacity to collect the specific demographic requirements. Without their assistance, our ability to distribute to those who need it most is limited at best. To ensure Manna Packs are delivered to those who actually need it, expect that specific demographic reporting is our best guess. Our focus will be on feeding who needs it the most and we will report as best we are able.
