This place is in a vulnerable state and with many precariousness, the people here live on the hill exposed to a lot of humidity due to a climate that in winter creates excessive fog, causing various types of respiratory illnesses, especially in children. Many diners attend this communal pot, the cost for a portion is 3.50 soles and in the economic context of our country it is very affordable for Peruvians.

Diego, from a very young age, has been very independent and rebellious. He took refuge in alcohol as a way to leave home. Before his medical condition, he worked on the streets on a tricycle, buying scrap metal to later resell it to a company. He suffered an accident when he fell off a truck and was hit by another vehicle. His friends took him to the "Sembrando esperanza" house because he needed help with food, medicine, and a place to sleep. Currently, he has lost his vision, cannot walk, and cannot get around; he uses a walker. He also told us that he previously had a relationship, but due to health issues, they abandoned it. He has no children.

He is currently awaiting surgery. He feels the need for his surgery to be done soon so he can work.

What Are Their Living Conditions?

Beatriz lives in the San Francisco de Pariachi human settlement, she is a single mother, her husband passed away in 2019 due to a lung disease. Since then, she has become the breadwinner of her home for her children, since her two oldest children, Edith and Hector, suffer from a vision disease that allows them to work but with limitations. Beatriz sells spices in the market, which are liquefied inputs to prepare meals. She is a street vendor, the earnings are minimal, however, she fights for her family. Her house is currently made of wood with corrugated iron roofs and a dirt floor.

Describe The Types Of Needs This Individual Has.

Her primary and urgent need is for her two older children, as their treatment is very expensive and the medications are beyond her financial means. In addition, Vania, her youngest daughter, plays on the dirt floor, suffering from infections caused by dust and lint.
