

Why Were The Items Distributed Here? What Are The Greatest Needs In This Community?

We learned about Barbara from her grandmother Julia who was helping out a neighbor who was getting new prefabricated home built by one of the CDV visiting mission teams. Touched by Barbara's story, the short term missionaries left an offering to purchase medicine, diapers, food, and other items for Barbara and her family. The Manna Pack was delivered with these items in addition to a new wheelchair.

Barbara lives in Callao, the largest port in Peru and while it is its own province, it is considered part of greater Metropolitan Lima. It is one of the most dangerous areas of the country with lots of gang activity, drugs and violent crime. Security for the families living there is a great need and there's lots of fear. Extortion has skyrocketed in recent years leaving all store owners and residents fearful. It also can be fairly difficult to access because it is controlled by criminals making it complicated to work and solve problems that afflict the area. It's an area of great economic need.

Name



The majority of Barbara's needs are health related. She is a 13-year-old girl who was born with hydrocephalus and myelomeningocele (the most severe type of spina bifida). She also has a peritoneal ventricle valve shunt to drain fluid from the brain, a slanted palate and a dislocated hip and foot. Barbara suffers from low hemoglobin and requires a wheelchair for mobility.

As a result of all of these medical issues, one of the greatest needs of the family is financial. She needs expensive medicines and the use of adult diapers daily.

How Did This Donation Meet These Needs And Make A Lasting Impact?

The gift of the Manna Pack was greatly appreciated due to its nutritional value and since Barbara suffers from low hemoglobin. The Manna Pack rice will help provide essential nutrients like iron, folic acid, and vitamin B12, which are crucial for red blood cell production. It can increase hemoglobin levels and reduce anemia, especially where rice is a staple in the diet. This will allow her to have more and healthier food and assist in raising her hemoglobin levels. Due to all the challenges that her health presents, it is vital that Barbara have a balanced and nutritional diet.


Why Were The Items Distributed Here? What Are The Greatest Needs In This Community?

We learned about Mrs. Sheyla when, as volunteers at the the La Voz Animal Shelter, we carried out a social service project cleaning the kennels and walking the dogs around the grounds. La Voz Animal Shelter is located in Chilca, Cañete, Lima. They currently house 180 dogs and 90 cats, all rescued from the streets. All were abandoned and left to roam the streets and the majority of them were sick and malnourished. When we arrived, we were greeted by euphoric barking.

Chilca is a coastal town with a mix of industrial and agricultural business. There is a water shortage in Chilca and the area surrounding the animal shelter consists of dusty, undeveloped land due to the lack of paved roads.

Why Were The Items Distributed Here? What Are The Greatest Needs In This Community?

In partnership with the Municipality of Callao, we were able to bless the community with boxes of Manna Pack fortified rice. The rice was provided to all of the district's Community Kitchens (Ollas Comunes). These kitchens are where neighbors come together pooling their resources to provide at least one healthy meal a day for families. The families provide the volunteer manpower and pay a small fee (usually about \$1 per person) for each meal so that more supplies can be purchased. Meals for the elderly or handicapped are provided for free.

Callao is known for high levels of insecurity and corruption, and has been largely neglected by its authorities, which has disrupted public order. As a church, we are bringing a message of hope and love as we distribute the boxes of Manna Pack. We met Isabel during the distribution of the boxes of rice and heard her story.

What Are Their Living Conditions?
Isabel is a single mother of two who lives in the hills of the Callao district. To get to her home, she has to take minibusses and climb many stairs up the hillside.
She told us that her house is made of woven mats with a dirt floor and a corrugated iron roof; it lacks running water, sewage and electricity.

Isabel's greatest need is for financial resources and a secure, stable job where she can earn a fixed salary to support her household. She occasionally works doing laundry and house cleaning for others. These funds allow her to care for her children, but she has no other financial resources and her small income is not enough to make ends meet for food, clothing, school supplies and other basic needs.

We know Mr. Felix since the pandemic, in principle Zoila who is a volunteer of our house gave him help, since then the support provided, due to his condition and the 3 grandchildren abandoned by his mother and 1 40-year-old son with extreme psychological delay of which else is in charge, his three grandchildren Dominique, Dyron and Dylan are registered as by him and his wife who died 8 years ago. Mr. Felix cannot work since he was operated on the prostate on two occasions, so he cannot make any kind of effort. He lives from the charity of the neighbors who support them in one way or another. His house is very humble, it has basic water and electricity services. The mother of her grandchildren has addiction problems, she lives on the street.

The church provides help to this family every 4 months or so since their situation is of extreme poverty.

The Santa Rosa - Ancón sector is located at the northern end of the coast of Metropolitan Lima,

integrating two neighboring jurisdictions: the Santa Rosa district and the historic resort of Ancón. Its location on the coastal axis of Lima Norte makes it a strategic point for urban, tourism and environmental development. We can mention several needs that this family has been going through, among which are, food, clothing, education, etc. because Mr. Gelix cannot work, they only live on the help of the neighbors and the church, that's why the help is done every 3 or 4 months. Especially on dates such as the beginning of school, July 28, Christmas and on any other occasion that we have donations. Jhair lost his sight from one moment to the next and added to that he has his delay being also an urgent need to cover.
