**What Was The Crisis And When Did It Take Place?** Hanna, a 45-year-old teacher, has dedicated her life to education and children. Before the war, she worked at a local college, where she taught Ukrainian language and literature. However, active hostilities forced her to leave her hometown. Her house was damaged by shelling, and living there became dangerous. In a hurry, Hanna was able to take only the most necessary things, leaving most of her belongings in a destroyed apartment.

**After moving to a new city, she rented a small apartment, but it was completely empty. Living without furniture was difficult - there was no place to sleep, store clothes, or work on materials for students. Despite the fact that Hanna continued to teach remotely, she was struggling financially: rent, household expenses, and adaptation to the new place took up almost all of her savings.**

**After asking for help, Hanna received the necessary furniture from a public organization in cooperation with the charity "World Help". For her, this was a real blessing. The support she received helped her create a cozy corner at home, feel stable, and be able to work fully again.**
