What Are Their Living Conditions? The family lives in a rural area with limited employment opportunities. Oleksiy is forced to frequently travel to other settlements to earn money, performing heavy physical labor.

Describe The Types Of Needs This Individual Has. Alexey's life crisis stems from an injury he sustained many years ago while working on a construction site, which left him with the loss of one eye. Since then, he has had to constantly monitor his health, but access to medical services in his village is limited.

How Did This Donation Meet These Needs And Make A Lasting Impact? The Manna Pack rice aid provided practical support for the family. It is a nutritious product that can be easily prepared and included in the daily diet.

For Alexey, this trip was especially important, as he was able to not only receive a food package, but also undergo an ophthalmological examination without having to go to the city.

Why Were The Items Distributed Here? What Are The Greatest Needs In This Community? Assistance was provided in the city of Pivdenoukrainsk for internally displaced persons who were forced to leave their homes due to the war. In this city, many families have found temporary shelter, but continue to live in conditions of uncertainty and limited resources.

The meeting, which combined humanitarian assistance and an evangelistic gathering, gathered about 100 people. For security reasons, the distribution of assistance was carried out in the evening.

People received:

- fresh bread;
- sets with socks, sweets, hygiene products;
- Manna Pack rice.

The greatest needs of the community:

- basic food products;
- hygiene products;
- emotional (psychological) support for families;
- stable income for IDPs.

What Are Their Living Conditions? The family lives in temporary conditions as internally displaced persons. Marina is forced to combine caring for a young child with part-time work, which limits her opportunities for stable income, as her husband is a military man and does not currently live with them.

Their life is built around saving and finding ways to provide for basic needs.

Describe The Types Of Needs This Individual Has.The crisis for the family began after the full-scale invasion in 2022. For some time, the family still lived in their hometown, Oleksandrivka, but later, due to the worsening security situation, they had to leave their home and move to Pivdennoukrainsk in search of a safer place to live.

A year ago, Marina's husband was mobilized into the ranks of the Armed Forces of Ukraine. Since then, she has been taking care of her child and providing for her family on her own.

Marina has the following needs:

Food needs — providing food for the child;

Financial stability — limited income;

Support for the military family — the absence of her husband nearby;

Household needs — hygiene products, clothing;

Emotional support — living in a state of constant stress, worrying about her child and husband.

How Did This Donation Meet These Needs And Make A Lasting Impact? The assistance received has become a tangible support for Marina in her daily life. Manna Pack rice is a nutritious and versatile product that is easy to prepare, especially for a child. Since her daughter loves porridge, this product will become an important part of their diet. Together with other things — bread, hygiene products and basic kits — the assistance has partially reduced the family's expenses and directed funds to other important needs. In addition to the material component, this meeting has become a source of emotional support. Communication, attention and a common atmosphere have helped people feel that they are not left alone with their difficulties.

What Are Their Living Conditions? The family lives in a house that needs partial renovation. Living conditions are basic, but due to the large number of family members, resources are quickly exhausted. The mother does not work, as she is fully occupied with caring for the children and running the household.

Describe The Types Of Needs This Individual Has. The family's difficult life situation gradually developed due to financial difficulties. The family lives on one income - Vasyl's earnings, who works as a handyman, as well as social benefits.

In the winter, there are fewer opportunities for work, which further complicates the situation. At the same time, expenses for a large family remain high, especially for food, clothing, and treatment of children.

The family has the following needs:

Food needs - ensuring proper nutrition for children;

Financial stability - limited income for a large family;

Medical needs - treatment of children;

Housing needs - home renovation;

Household needs - clothing and necessary things for children;

Social support - assistance to large families.
