The items were distributed at this school because it serves some of the most vulnerable children in the community, including students with special needs and Syrian students who missed access to formal education and struggle with basic reading and writing skills. The school lacked the resources to provide appropriate furniture, especially for students with special health and physical needs.

The greatest needs in this community are inclusive educational support, suitable learning equipment, and remedial education opportunities that help out-of-school and displaced children catch up academically, improve their confidence, and integrate into age-appropriate classes.

**Describe The Types Of Needs The School, Students, And Teachers Have.**

The school serves diverse educational needs through an inclusive program, with a morning program for students with special needs and an evening remedial program for Syrian students who missed formal education and struggle with basic reading and writing. Students with special needs require appropriate seating and a supportive learning environment to meet their physical and psychological needs. Teachers need suitable classroom resources to help students focus, participate, and learn effectively.

## **How Did This Donation Meet These Needs And Make A Lasting Impact?**

The donated specialized desks and chairs provided stability and comfort for students with special needs, enabling them to sit properly, participate positively, and better receive information from teachers. The furniture also improved students' psychological well-being by making them feel valued and distinguished. Teachers reported that the desks were highly beneficial due to their comfortable design, adequate table space, and appealing appearance, which enhanced the overall learning environment and will have a lasting impact on student engagement and educational outcomes.

### Why Were The Items Distributed Here? What Are The Greatest Needs In This Community?

The items were distributed to this family in Al-Mafraq, Al-Dhahya neighborhood, because they are living in extreme poverty. The father is unable to work due to severe health conditions, and the family's only income is a small social assistance payment of 149 JOD. Their home is in very poor condition, and they lacked basic necessities, such as a proper mattress for sleeping.

The greatest needs in this community include basic household items (like mattresses and furniture), medical support for ill family members, financial assistance for families without income, and improved living conditions for children and adults living in extreme poverty.

The items were distributed to Ashwaq and her children in the Eastern district of Duqrah because the family is living under extreme poverty. The father is imprisoned for a major case for six years, and the mother remarried early, leaving her to care for her children alone. Their home is very small, with only one room, a tiny kitchen, and a narrow entrance, and they struggle to meet basic needs such as clothing, food, and shelter.

The greatest needs include basic clothing for children and adults, school supplies, proper shelter to protect against rain and weather, and access to nutritious food. Many families here experience poverty quietly due to pride, but the lack of essentials deeply affects children's education, health, and well-being.
