Describe the types of needs the school, students, and teachers have.:

The greatest need the students have is food. The cost of living has risen dramatically and is very difficult to find a job in Haiti, especially in our town of Ouanaminthe. The other need is medical care, but we are able to provide that through the hospital on our campus.

How did this donation meet these needs and make a lasting impact?:

Anouse is a single father to 4 children, 2 boys and 2 girls. They are from Port au Prince. He was a car and motorcycle taxi, living a decent life with his family. One night at midnight, gang members entered their home, shot his wife in the chest and head and shot him two times in the right leg. His leg got infected and he lost his leg and his wife. He lived with someone until he was kicked out and then someone suggested he come to Ouanaminthe. He attended our church when he came to town and we helped him rent a home and took two of his sons into our school.

Please provide a direct quote from the student/staff about how they feel after receiving this donation.:

"I am a handicap father that's trying to survive and help my children. Life is very hard and things are not easy at all but I'm happy and grateful to be alive today with my children. I am all that they have left. Most days I'm struggling to feed all of them. The two oldest ones that are in school at Danita's Children eat a meal there during the school week, so that helps take pressure off me and they always tell me how much they love the Manna Pack and wish they could eat a plate every single day. The Manna Pack that I received today is a huge blessing. I was not expecting it at all but at least now I know I have food to cook for my children. Food plays a huge role in people's lives. I can not stand seeing my children go hungry. That broke my heart every single time. There is a lot of hunger and malnourished children, even adults, all around Haiti. I'm new to this new environment, but Danita's Children Church makes me feel better, treats me with love and takes care of me and my children. Again, thank you for choosing to help my people and for helping me feed my children. Always and forever, I will be grateful for that." - Anouse

Mirvil has been living with a friend, so one of her greatest needs is a place to rent of her own. The other need is food. The rice has been a great blessing and we hope to continue to help her with more food!

How did this donation meet these needs and make a lasting impact?:

Mirvil lives with her daughter, Elissa, who has suffered from malnutrition. Also, has a medical condition and is being treated at Danita's Children. She has been living with a friend. Elissa is her only child. The father used to beat her when she was pregnant, so after she gave birth, she ran away and found refuge in Ouanaminthe. This donation has helped provide stability for Mirvil and her daughter in the midst of extreme instability due to the abuse she suffered.

"When the nurse at Danita's Children told me that I was chosen to be blessed with the Manna Pack, I was overjoyed because I know how much this is going to help me with my daughter. Rosemila has is food. Most of the children who attend our school eat one meal a day and that is the meal they receive at our school.

This donation is a tangible way to show the love of Jesus. Rosemila is a faithful church member. She attends every week and oftentimes, we see her volunteering by washing chairs, cleaning, etc. This donation helps take the burden off of her, especially on the weekends, when she has to feed her sons.

"My boys and I have come a very very long way. I have been a single mom to the boys since birth. Danita's Children have been helping me and the kids ever since they were toddlers. My two boys go to Hope for Haiti School and they receive a meal every single day for lunch. My boys love the Manna Pack rice so much and they will eat it anytime! I was so very happy to receive these boxes of rice. Those will help me with kids because on the weekends, we will have something to cook as I am not working. Most weekends when the boys are not in school they do not eat something because it's really hard for me to provide the meal that they need. To have food is such a great blessing that is why we are happy and grateful for the rice. We want to thank you for thinking about us and blessing us with food to eat. May God bless you always!" - Rosemila.
